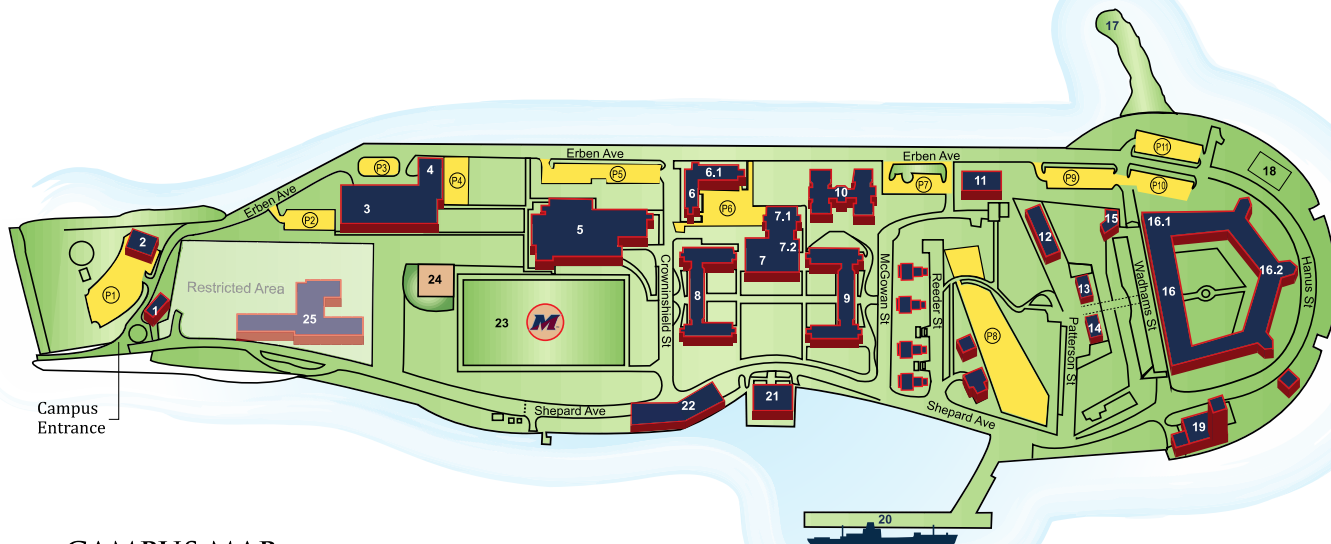

NOTES

- DRILL WEEKEND** - Report to LPO with attendance. **We must hand in a roster of attendees the Thursday before drill.**
- UNIFORMS / ID** – Complete Uniforms with flashes and name tapes are required by all cadets. Hydration canteens and proper winter gear are part of your uniform. All cadets need their ID cards placed in the top right pocket of NWU blouse. Cadets are required to be cleaned-shaved. This means **NO FACIAL HAIR**. For more information read the website at georgewashingtondivision.org **Cadets that do not meet regulations will be sent home.**
- ATTENDANCE** – USNSCC Regulations state that you must attend 75% of all scheduled drills. That is four (4) of six (6) drills per quarter. If you do not meet this minimum standard, you will be administratively warned. If you continue to fail to meet minimum attendance standards, you will be discharged from the NSCC/NLCC.
